Emmanuel Baptist Church Annual Church Members Meeting

Our Church Constitution requires that we hold an Annual General Meeting 'to approve annual accounts and reports, to appoint Auditors or Independent Examiners and to consider proposals for the strategy and vision of the church in the coming year'.

Our Annual General Meeting will take place on July 19th at 7.30pm.

It has also been our practice to see the Annual General Meeting as an opportunity to nominate for the role of Elder and the role of Deacon, (Please note that under our constitution nominations for Elders and Deacons may be made at any Church members meeting).

Elders

Elders, in conjunction with the Pastor, are responsible for the spiritual life of the fellowship. They also have a legal responsibility as trustees of the Church.

Our present Elders are Nigel Bird, Yinka Adewole, and Tony Chadwick.

Deacons

Deacons are responsible for the day to day administration and organisation of the Church and support the Pastor and Elders in the spiritual life of the Church. They also have a legal responsibility as trustees of the Church.

Our present Deacons are: Rick Cookman, Tony Jeavons, Emma Munden, Nathan Offord and Justin Day.

Strengthening the Leadership Team

Over the past several months there has been considerable consultation and discussion about strengthening and broadening the leadership team at EBC. We have identified a number of Deacon roles, which if filled, would considerably enhance the leadership team and therefore the life of the fellowship. These roles are:-
