## Sermon Outline Notes:

Acts 28 v 1 - 10

“Shipwrecks Make Way For Opportunities”

1) Solid ground v1. Explain the feeling you might have after being two weeks in a storm and finally getting ashore. Can read Acts 27

2) Unusual Kindness (favour) v2 from unusual people. Discuss.

3) Gathered fire wood v3 Getting stuck in to local community. Not me and mine / but how can I help.

4) Snake bite v4 Enemy attacks even when we're doing good. Has this ever happened to you?

5) Shake it off v5 Dealing with the enemy. (not every problem is from the enemy though) What do you think?

6) People always watching us v6 What do they see in you?

7) Publius v7 a person of peace. What does that mean?

8) Opportunity to pray and no doubt preach v8. How often do you Pray or testify to others?

9) Whole Island came v9 The way was opened. Is God opening a way for something special at the moment?

10) Furnished by others so could continue v10. God provides. Trust in Him.

Discuss in the light of Paul's experience how God works all things together for our Good and His Glory and how maintaining our Christian testimony at all times is crucial.
